

Centrolepis polygyna
Commonly: Wiry Centrolepis
Vascular Plant Family: Centrolepidiaceae

Flowers in spring

Centrolepis polygyna is an annual herb up to 8.5cm high. The stems are longer than the leaves, and reddish towards the base. The leaves are few to many about 1.5cm long and 0.5mm wide.



The flower heads are dark brown, about 1mm wide with 1-3 flower groups. The flowers are tiny, distinctly male or female in groups of 1 male flower and a few fused female flowers, all without floral segments.
