Templetonia retusa

Commonly: Cockies Tongues Vascular Plant Family: Fabaceae

Flowers late autumn to early summer

Templetonia retusa is a shrub to 3m tall with bluishgreen leaves.



The leaves are scattered without a stalk, 60mm long and 25mm wide, the tip with a notch.



The red, pea- flowers are up to 40mm long with 1 or 2 in a leaf axil. The calyx is 2-lipped with the upper lip broad and the lower lip of 3 rounded lobes. There are 5 petals, the standard petal is reflexed. The 2 lateral petals are nearly equal in length to the keel petals. The 10 stamens are united into an open sheath.



The fruit is stalked, compressed up to 70mm long and 15mm wide.
