*Trifolium campestre Commonly: Hop Clover Vascular Plant Family: Fabaceae

Flowers winter to early summer

**Trifolium campestre* is a ground hugging annual herb to 20m tall. It is native to Europe and western Asia.




The leaves are alternate, with 3, minutely toothed leaflets up to 10mm long and 5mm wide. The terminal leaflet is stalked. The stipules at the base of the leaf are joined to the leaf stalk.



The inflorescence is stalked up to 15mm wide and long. There are 20-50 yellow flowers in each head.



The standard petal is up to 5mm long hooded over the wings and keel.
