

***Phyllangium divergens***

**Commonly: No common name**

**Vascular Plant Family: Loganiaceae**

Flowers in spring

*Phyllangium divergens* is an annual herb up to 2cm tall. It has fine wiry stems and opposite leaves. The leaves are oval up to 1cm long and 3mm wide.

The inflorescence is of solitary flowers or of 2-5 flower clusters. The flowers, not visible in these photographs are white up to 4mm across. The cup shaped structure supporting the flowers is 3-5mm long and 8 or 9 veined. The lobes are 1-2mm long. In the photograph below there are 4 obvious veins on this side making a total of 8 veins on the whole structure.
