

Threlkeldia diffusa
Commonly: Coast Bonefruit
Vascular Plant Family: Chenopodiaceae

Flowers spring

Threlkeldia diffusa is a sprawling shrub to 30cm.



The leaves are scattered, without a stalk, cylindrical, fleshy and up to 3cm long.

The flowers are solitary, in the axils of the leaves. They are green up to 2mm long. The calyx is 3-lobed, fleshy with membranous lobes. There are no petals but 3 stamens.



The fruiting calyx is urn-shaped up to 3mm long with a shallow 3-lobed apex. It is woody with a thin dark blue to black flesh.
